Our project seeks

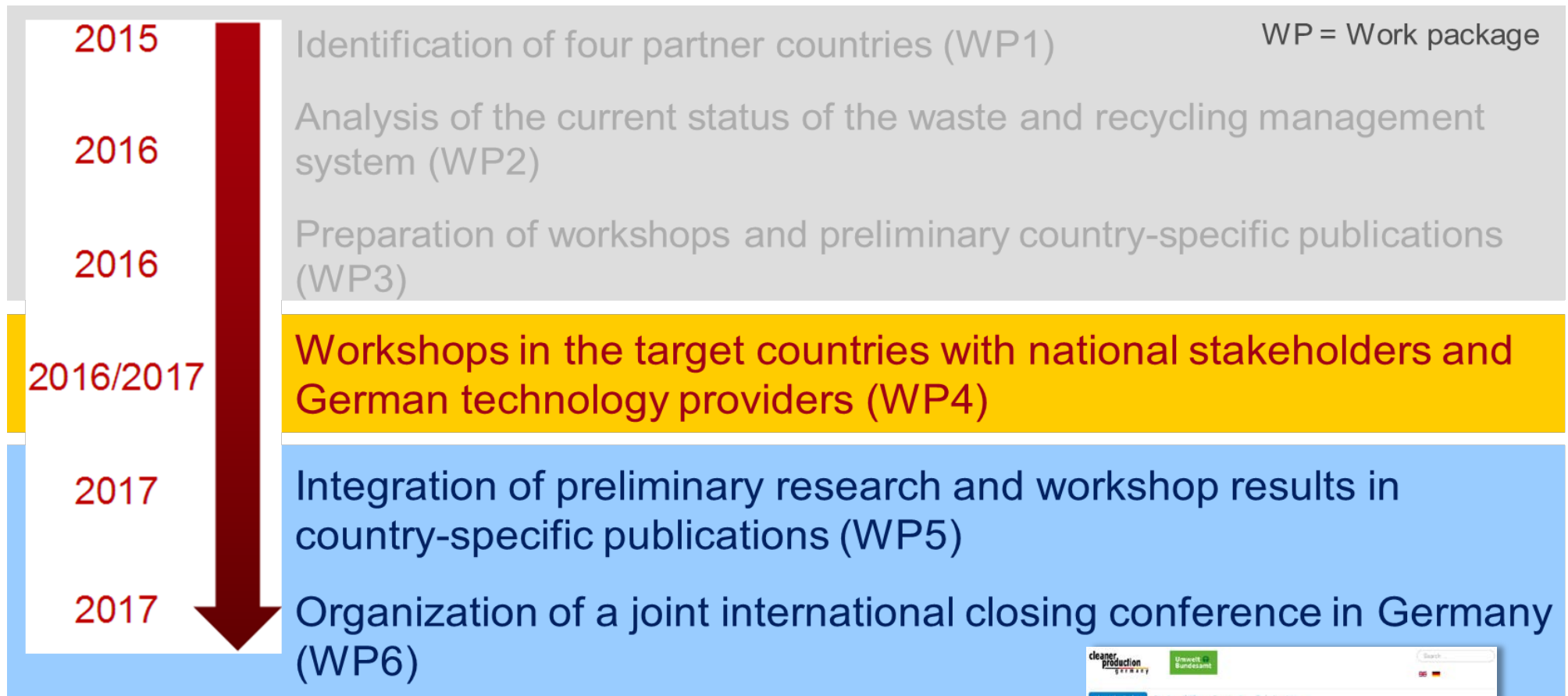
- **to sharpen the picture on SWM development potentials**

- Output sought from the workshop

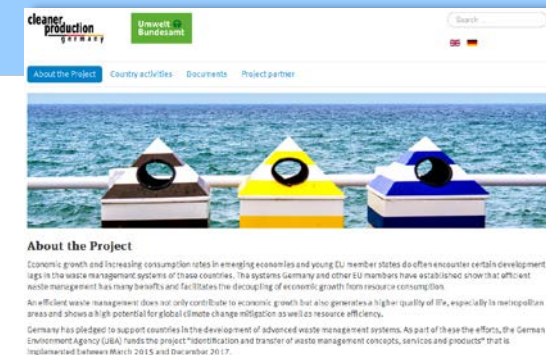
- further **insights and verification** as far as current findings and proposals from the project are concerned
